Novak wins Aussie open

Novak Djokovic retained his Australian Open title by beating his fierce rival Rafael Nadal 5-7 6-4 6-2 6-7 (5-7) in an epic five hours 53 minutes to win his fifth Grand Slam. It was the longest final in Grand Slam history. Djokovic, who also beat the Spaniard in their previous six meetings, has now triumphed at the last three majors. but this might be the sweetest of them all.

It is co-hosted by Gabon and Equatorial Guinea. The tournament kicked off on 21/01/12 without footballing 'household' names like Cameroon, Nigeria and the current holders, Egypt. There have been shocks already, with one time powerhouse Senegal going home in the early stages. Some Pundits fancy Ghana or Ivory Coast to lift the Cup in a tournament which ends on 12/02/12. Others think it is the most open of tournaments and no one is in pole position.
